IMPORTANT INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

The student and parent must register at the high school on June 10th, 11th or 12th between 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM. Payment is due at registration. Students may register for no more than two courses.

ATTENDANCE

All students *must* attend each day of summer school from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. (Afternoon sessions may be offered in addition to the morning sessions.)

If a student misses a session, he/she must bring an excuse from a parent. Students who miss 5 or more sessions will *not* earn credit for the course.

Since we will be using the on-line *Edgenuity* system, students will be able to continue working on their courses at home in the evenings and on the weekends. Students who successfully finish the course with a passing grade before July 13th will not have to continue attending.
